The Cannabis Clinic is a special project of the Alcohol & Other Drugs Service and Central Coast Health.

Who can access the Cannabis Clinic?

Any person over sixteen years of age who wants to stop or significantly cut down their cannabis use.

Parents requiring information, support and brief counselling regarding their children's cannabis use.

People who have stopped and want support to prevent relapse.

People who have been reluctant to seek help for their cannabis use in the past.

Current mental health clients who have identified problematic cannabis use.
